It's no wonder the organisers of UK club night Gorgeous asked Tammy Tinawi to bring the concept to Dubai – the ex-model is as sociable as she is beautiful. In Dubai since 2002, 26-year-old Tammy has spent the past seven years working at bringing international club nights and DJs to the region. "Promoting club nights and DJs really is a passion and my forte," she says, smiling. "There's nothing better than when you get a packed club night, with amazing music and a lively crowd – it's just brilliant and rewarding." As well as launching world famous club brands Hed Kandi and Ministry of Sound in Dubai, there's barely a venue left in the city that Tammy hasn't injected her lively, innovative ideas into, including Hat Club at The Apartment (guests can only enter wearing some form of head gear). "I think the clubbing scene is a

bit saturated at the moment to be honest," explains Tammy, who previously co-launched her own company Prestige Clubbing, now defunct. "That said, there are some amazing nights here for everyone, whether it's a party at Atlantis' Nasimi beach, an intimate indie event at Alpha, or a night of hip-hop at 400 Club – we're spoiled for choice." Tammy has also worked at managing and promoting DJs, including The Beat Thieves from the UK and Dubai's own protégé Greg Sharpe, now a resident in Rio de Janeiro, proving that the gorgeous brunette seriously knows her stuff. "My goal is to branch out and work on putting festivals together, which I'm actually currently just getting into, with Dubai Sound City," she grins. "I'm busy at the moment promoting the festival so I guess I'm half way there already." >
